

Guidelines for Drive-In Worship

For those leading worship:

- Maintain the recommended 6' distance at all times. Minimize team needed for leading in worship.
- Use a different microphone for every person leading worship. If there are not enough microphones to avoid sharing, wipe each microphone with a disinfecting wipe thoroughly between uses.
- Anything that will be touched by multiple users such as keyboards, music stands, sound boards, etc. must be disinfected after use.
- Gloves and masks must be worn when setting up and tearing down equipment.

For those assisting in worship:

- Communicate ahead of time and before worship the FM station that is being used.
- Decide if and how you want to communicate worship order and sign-in – not give an order of worship or email one out ahead of time, access online at church website or print one. For sign-in, use FB check in or sign in online. For printed material:
 - All items needed for worship (song sheets, bulletins, attendance cards, communion elements, etc.) are placed in a ziploc bag.
 - Greeters must wear masks and gloves when handing out the bagged worship items.
- If using bulletins, attendance cards, etc., they must be handled with gloves at all times (during printing, folding, etc.)
- Parking lot attendants must wear masks and gloves.
- Large bins are placed at the exits for worshipers to deposit their offerings, attendance cards, etc. as they leave the service.

For worshipers:

- Abide by the motto: "Come as you are but stay in your car."
- If your car is less than 6 feet away from the neighboring car, leave your windows closed.
- Place attendance cards (if using), offering, etc. back in the provided ziploc bag and drop them in the bin at the exit.
- If you need to exit the car for any reason such as to use the restroom, wear a mask. Only one from each car should leave to use the restroom unless assisting a child or someone with special needs.

Restroom Facilities:

- Doors leading to restrooms are always propped open.

- Create a touchless environment throughout the restroom experience (including soap & water dispensers).
- Signs are placed to remind users to abide by CDC guidelines.
- Hand sanitizer is placed in each restroom.

Other Considerations:

- Persons exhibiting any signs of illness should not participate in any way in the drive-in worship experience.
- Persons separating items placed in the large exit bins must use masks and gloves at all times.
- Persons counting money must wear gloves and masks.
